All forms and payment must be submitted by the 16th June 2023.

- 1. Only real Dachshunds will be allowed to race. We reserve the right to determine which dogs are wieners and which are not.
- 2. All racers must submit a registration form and shots record for each dog. All owners are required to sign a waiver releasing event sponsors and volunteers from liability.
- 3. The number of qualifying heats will be dependent on the total number of registered dogs. The first-place dog from each heat will compete in additional rounds to narrow down the field to the finals.
- 4. All dogs must have two people to race. One handler at the start and one at the finish you are not permitted to run along side your dog.
- 5. You can use treats, toys, or stuffed animals to entice your dog towards the line, however they must not be thrown or tossed. No lights, laser pointers, loud items, or items thrown down the track will be allowed
- 6. All dogs must start the dash with all paws on the ground. No throwing or tossing the dog over the line or you will be disqualified. First dog completely across the finish line will be the winner. All judges decisions are final

- 7. Once all paperwork and registration has been submitted your dog will be submitted into the draw
- 8. No humans on the dog track area
- 9. All dogs must be on a leash at- all- times while not in the race area. Once finished with the races they must be put back on their leashes. Dogs must be on a leash at all times apart from the actual race.
- 10. Owners MUST clean up after their own dogs ensure you have your own clean up gear.
- 11. If you are under 18, you must have a legal guardian to participate.
- 12. We reserve the right to disqualify any pet/owner for behaviour deemed inappropriate.
- 13. Please remember this is for fun! Although prizes are up for grabs no inappropriate behaviour will be accepted.

Tip for all catchers...The closer you are to the finish line, the more likely your dog is to slow down before the finish line. Please stay back from the line.
